

SPREADING SCAM AWARENESS



Scams run rampant! Use these tips to avoid becoming a victim.

SLAM the Scam

Spot phishing emails by using the SLAM method.



Sender

Carefully analyze who the email came from.



Links

Hover over links—without clicking—to see where it may take you.



Attachments

Ask yourself if you were expecting an attachment.



Message

Look for misspellings, generic greetings and requests to take action.

RECEIVE AN UNSOLICITED CALL, TEXT OR EMAIL?



Don't respond or give personal info!



Don't be fooled if the individual shares basic info about you!



Scammers can spoof caller ID, email addresses and websites. Don't take these details at face value! Instead, contact via another channel.



If it's a phone call, find a verified number or reach out through another legitimate channel.

BUT THEY SOUND SO REAL!

That's the goal! Scammers have become incredibly convincing and know that good customer service and attention to detail help sell their story—but don't get caught up! If it sounds suspicious or too good to be true, trust your instincts!
